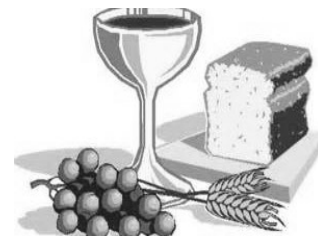

**Our Parish Outreach programs provide essential food programs that nourish families,  
especially those needed during the summer months.**

Summer is a wonderful time for youngsters who long for fun-in-the sun activities and a break from the school year. Unfortunately for many families, summer can mean months of worry and hunger, as kids lose access to healthy meals given at school. Food insecurity is real on Long Island. According to LI Cares, more than 200,000 families, almost 70,000 children, do not have access to sufficient food, or food of an adequate quality, to meet one's basic needs. As parents juggle the ongoing rising costs at the supermarket, gas pumps, housing, utilities and medical co-pays, they turn to the Parish Outreach to find relief.

Sin embargo, para muchas familias el verano significa hambre y preocupación pues durante esos meses los niños no recibirán las comidas nutritivas de la escuela. La inseguridad alimentaria es un problema real en Long Island. De acuerdo con el Banco de Alimentos Long Island Cares, más de 200,000 familias, es decir 70,000 niños no reciben la calidad o cantidad adecuada de comida para cubrir sus necesidades básicas. Los elevados costos de salud, alimentos, gasolina y vivienda, hace que los padres acudan a las Oficinas de Alcance Social en busca de ayuda.

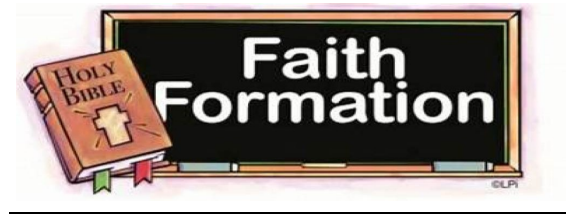
