Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In a few days we will enter into the ancient and holy season of Lent. This great season of discipline calls us to consider the Lord working in our lives on multiple levels: while we give up an amenity, take up a spiritual or corporal work of mercy, or undertake a healthy habit for the body and soul, we also draw closer to God in prayer.

The multi-layered experience of living the Christian life in the season of penance is a very rich opportunity for understanding the working of the Holy Spirit in our lives based on who we are individually. This individuality is understood both in our own right-mindedness but also in the context of God the Creator knowing us precisely for who we are.

Lent does not have to be a confusing or arduous time, though it is one of penance. It is a time that opens our eyes each year to a greater understanding of the reality of God with us. As the Bishop Jacques-Bénigne Bossuet preached at the beginning of Lent 300 years ago, “To see light, all we need to do is open our eyes; the light comes in by itself. There is no other path that we need to take to light. Truth is more than light itself, so nothing can take us to truth other than the truth itself. Christ the Truth humbled himself before us, so let us humble ourselves before him...Come then O Truth, you are the way.”

Let us pray the coming season will be spiritually fruitful and powerful in its enlightenment of our understanding of our Christian calling.

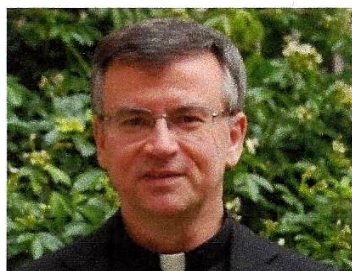
