Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday presents us with a calming address which understands the human condition. The Lord knows that we must work but he also remains close to assist. This is because he knows we are capable. Thanks to the grace of Baptism, he will be with us always. Saint Gaudentius of Brescia preaches well:

It is appropriate that we should receive the Body of Christ in the form of bread because, as there are many grains of wheat in the flour from which bread is made, by mixing it with water and baking it with fire, so also, we know that many members make up the One Body of Christ, which is brought to maturity by the fire of the Holy Spirit. *(Homila, VII)*

Let entrust ourselves this summer to the closeness of the God who knows us well.

On a practical note, I am continuing to search for summer help from priests to assist in St. Peter's in Amagansett for Sunday Mass, but it is difficult to find someone consistent for the summer and thus, still not possible. Summer moves fast but the parish is doing its best. Please pray for more priests!

St. Gaudentius explains the blessing of the Sunday Eucharist well, "In our inmost being, we shall be wholly sanctified by the very Lord Jesus Christ, Whom we believe to be present in His Sacraments and Whose boundless Power abides forever."

The translation here is, "the more Masses, the better." Most Holy Trinity will always do it's best.

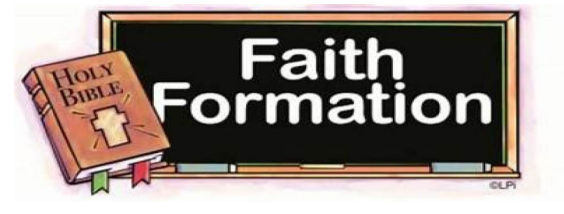

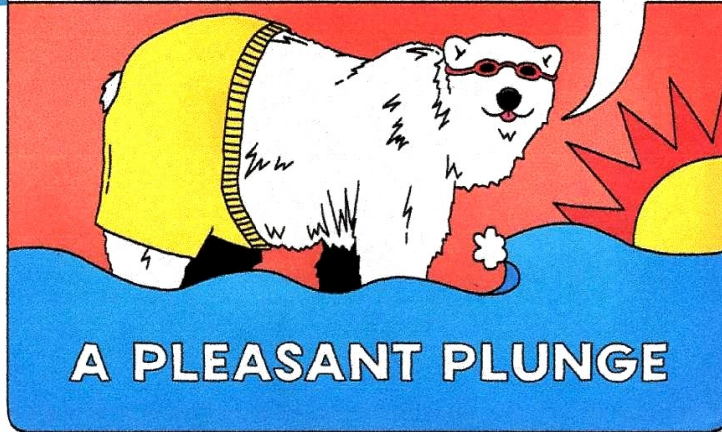

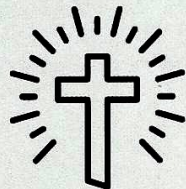
