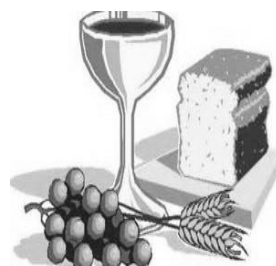

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we gradually observe the change to the season of Autumn, we contemplate the world around us as beautiful in both its changes and its regularity. At the same time, we recognize how comfortable it is to us while also beyond much of our control in its immensity- both on land and at sea. The same is true of the nature of God. Our understanding of the closeness and immensity of God the Creator was celebrated in a particular way this past Saturday on the Feast of St. Thérèse of Lisieux. St. Thérèse's "Little Way" was a contemplative approach to drawing close to the loving God of power through humility and confidence. The saint writes:

Heaven for me is hidden in a little Host Where Jesus, my Spouse, is veiled for love. I go to that Divine Furnace to draw out life, And there my Sweet Saviour listens to me night and day. (*The Little Way.*)

The Eucharist we celebrate each Sunday is a unique and powerful way of imbuing the power of the Holy Spirit into our individual souls and the spirit of the community in which we live. In our prayers, let us speak to the Lord with confidence and peace. Relaxing in the knowledge that he hears us and is always present is as important as observing his commands. Indeed, praying from the standpoint of peace allows for an easier obedience to the will of God.

As we begin a new month and season, let us be open to the unpredictable future before us and be open to the power of God to propel us forward in holiness.

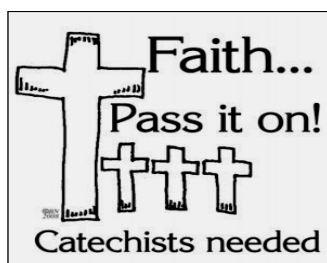
No class next Sunday, October 9<sup>th</sup> for the
