Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday we are invited to contemplate both the entrance of Christ into Jerusalem beginning Holy Week, but then also his death on the Cross, the end of his earthly sojourn in the holy city. The entrance into Jerusalem, bedecked (in a sense) with palms and olive branches is the fulfillment of Zechariah's prophecy: "Your king shall come to you; a just savior is her, meek and riding on an ass, not a colt, the foal of an ass. He shall banish the chariot from Ephraim, and the horse from Jerusalem; the warriors bow will be banished, and he will proclaim peace to the nations." (Zec. 9,9-10)

Unfortunately or not, the meek gesture is lost on the crowd, they celebrate his entrance using the same symbolic gesture the Jerusalemites used to celebrate the victory of Judas Maccabeus after their defeat of the Romans, with the laying down of palms. His fame had spread despite the repeated warnings he gave throughout the Gospel not to speak of what he was doing. The combination of worldliness in material and words and supernatural healing are mixing with one another in a tragedy that is about to culminate in the death of God.

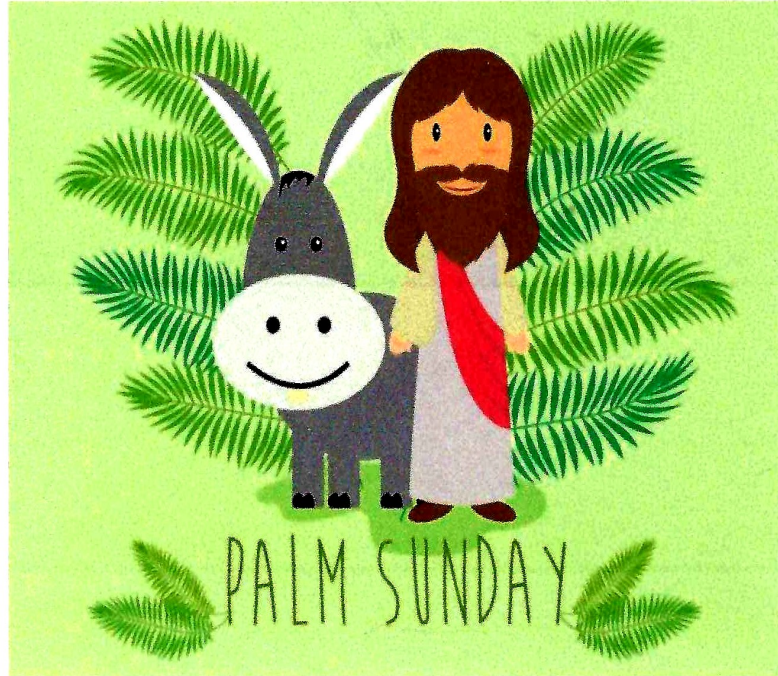
The Passion this Sunday speaks for itself. What we have seen in the sequence of actions however, is the fulfillment of the Old Testament prophecies in their proper form, substance, sequence, and words such that the swirl of worldly elements and the supernatural hints at the messiahship of Christ are now settled and we can get on to the salvation of mankind. To borrow from Shakespeare, what is past is prologue for the people of God.
