

We are looking for good people to become Catechists in the fall. We will be going back to in person classes and need Catechists to help instruct the children starting in September.


Any teenagers that would like to do community service for your school and for your up coming college transcripts. Please consider becoming a catechist and helping to educate the children of our parish in their faith.
