They are in need of a great number of items:

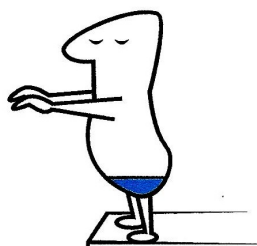

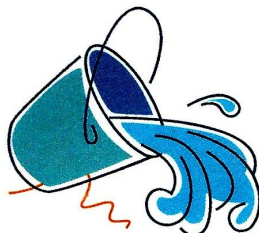

We will be going back to in person classes and need Catechists to help instruct the children starting in September.

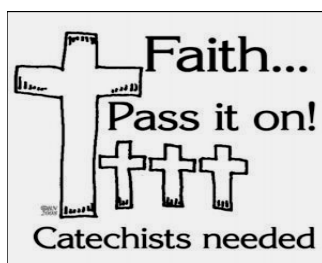
