Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

There is some housekeeping news to share: Shortly after Labor Day, Fr. Liam McDonald, Pastor of St. Thérèse in Montauk will take on the assignment of Vocation Director for our diocese, that is, recruitment of future priests.

At the same time, I will be assigned as the pastor of St. Thérèse in Montauk, while continuing as the pastor of Most Holy Trinity.

This is not a ‘merger’ of parishes.

The administrative offices of both parishes will continue to function with the independence which they currently enjoy.

Finances will not be merged.

Mass schedules and other particular liturgies, such as Marriages, will remain the same for the foreseeable future.

In September, Most Holy Trinity and St. Thérèse will also receive an Associate Pastor who will serve between the two parishes; we don’t know who it is yet but he will be selected over the summer.

Deacon Larry is arraigning to have his diaconal assignment extended to include St. Thérèse as well as Most Holy Trinity for additional sacramental help.

The Spanish Apostolates in both parishes will continue to function in the current fashion.

It will be a change in dynamics for most of us at Most Holy Trinity to have two priests trading the duty, especially between three churches, but I’m confident and grateful for the understanding of everyone in our two parishes that we’ll have a good adjustment so that our labor of spiritual fulfillment can continue unabated and thrive in new ways under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

May God bless us all!

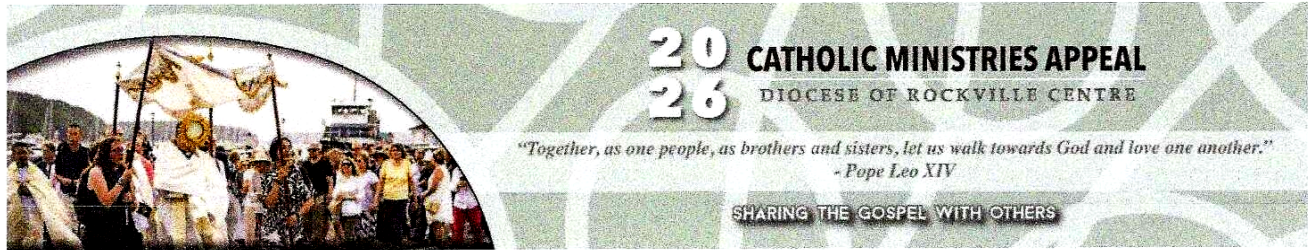

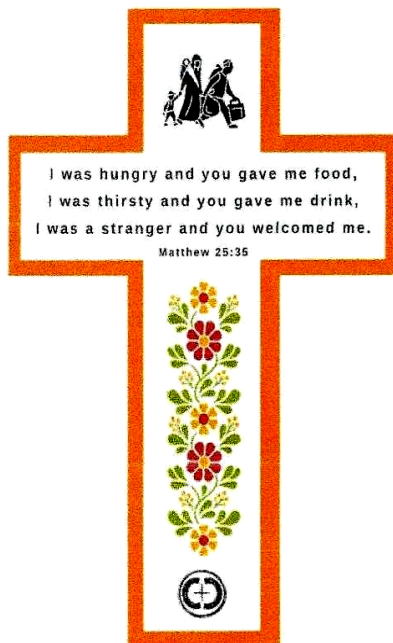
