Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The month of August is a powerful one on the Church's calendar, with the Feast of the Transfiguration on August 6th and the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven on August 15th.

In a certain sense, the two feasts are well joined in the month. With the Transfiguration, we see the growth of Jesus Christ into earthly glory and with the Assumption; we see the heavenly reward of the mother to whom God entrusted the care of his earthly presence. The month of August then, in the course of spiritual meditation, can easily be dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. To that purpose, I offer for spiritual mediation and consideration, the prayer of Fr. Jean Jaques Olier, a formator of priests from the late 1600's who entrust the care of parishes to the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary:

O Jesus, living in Mary, come and live in your servants, in the spirit of holiness, in the fullness of your power, in the perfection of your ways, in the truth of your virtues, in the communion of your mysteries. Rule over every adverse power, in your Spirit, for the glory of the Father. Amen.




