Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,


This Christmas season we once again turn to the miraculous Incarnation of Christ; the Son of God sent to us as Man. The Word in the flesh is presented to us with the angelic exclamation: "Peace to people of good will!" On this holiday we rejoice that peace follows the God present for us. Bishop Jacques-Bénigne Bossuet exhorts us at Christmas:

"This peace is the subject of the glory of God. Let us rejoice in this peace...because it glorifies God in the high throne of his glory; let us elevate ourselves to the high places, to the greatest height of the throne of God in order to glorify him in himself, and to love what he made in us only in relation to him." (*Élévations sur la naissance de Jésus-Christ* : 9.)

As we elevate our prayerful thoughts and mediation over the peace of God, this Christmas, let us 'go to the crib' and recognize the closeness of the Lord to us at all times. It is in beholding the miracle of God, swaddled in the humility of the manger when refresh our good will and elevate our minds to the high places and enjoy the reality of the throne of God. Kneeling at the crib anticipates the throne.

Far too often over the course of a year, we may not give enough credit to our individual senses of hope and the hard work that goes into living a life of faith, rooted in prayer and expressed in good works. This Christian path is built on the culture, civilization, and mindset of those who believe in the God who became Man. Let us thank the Lord for his gift of faith, hope, and love for us and to us; and use this Christmas to empower the next year as one of peace and holiness.

Candy Cane Holiday Christmas Fair




A big **Thank You** to all that helped at the fair on Sunday, December 7th.
