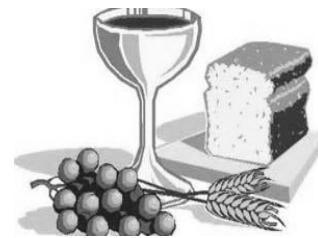

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

With this year's feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ, or *Corpus Christi*, the Universal Church is able to turn again to its great source and summit of belief and strength. As one, it gives thanks to God for as great a gift as the Eucharist and not only adores, but commits itself to protection and exultation.

In our own parish, there is a great Eucharistic sense following the last couple of weeks of First Communion and Confirmations, heralding in the greater numbers of churchgoers in the summer. For us, the feast of Corpus Christi stands at the beginning of an exciting time of the year. As we still open up fully following our pandemic protocols recession, it is no coincidence that the Eucharist is our reveille for a hopeful year. Let us pray well to the Lord as we gather for the Eucharist at his altar.

St. Thomas Aquinas describes the Eucharist with the same excitement so many of us experience in the relaxation of the summer, "What a priceless and marvelous banquet! So salutary and filled with sweets! What could be more precious? Nothing! For here our food is not the flesh of calves and goats, as under the old law, but Christ himself, true God. What, then, could be more marvelous than such a sacrament?" (Opusculum 57.)

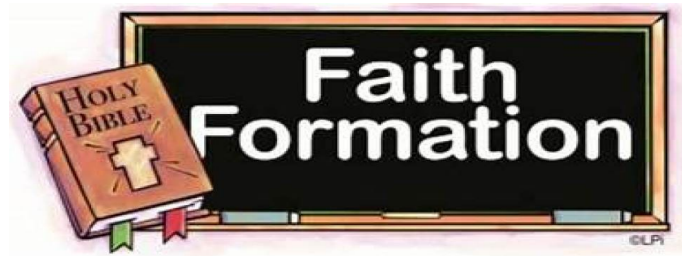

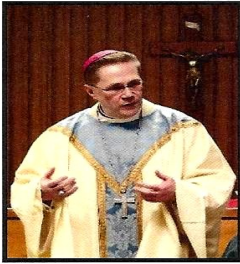
