Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Summer season, with its demands, has seemed to move very quickly on the parish this year; hopefully it means good things to come by God’s grace.

First, our summer schedule will require some patience. From Memorial Day, Saturday and Sunday Masses will be in East Hampton. We are not able to arrange for the Sunday 9am in St. Peter’s currently, but Deacon Larry and I are working on it. A posted schedule for the next couple of weeks will be forthcoming.

Secondly, the Vincentian Fathers who serve the Spanish-speaking community will be reassigned by their order to other locations at the end of June. The Sunday Spanish Mass at 7pm (and the Spanish Masses in other locations) will now be covered by two Spanish-speaking priests of our diocese, hopefully with minimal change, however there are details that still need to be discussed since I personally cannot pray that Mass every Sunday. The current prediction is that with the new priests of the diocese, living in Bridgehampton, and with our parish as one of the largest in the Latino community (and with a very popular Parish Hall,) we can keep to normal behavior.

Thirdly, if our summer life of faith can remain without too many changes, the beloved 7am Sunday Summer Mass may be possible in July, however it remains to be determined.

Lastly, people have asked about Deacon Larry’s absence and I want to let everyone know that he is well. In the last weeks, he has been tending to his mother-in-law, Angelina, who sadly passed away two Fridays ago. Please pray for her, Deacon Larry, and Angelina’s daughter, Christina, the deacon’s wife. Not to be too slowed down, he will be spending the next two weeks completing his Canon Law degree in Ottawa, Canada. While this is an explanation for his absence, it is also an insistence on prayers for our scholar!

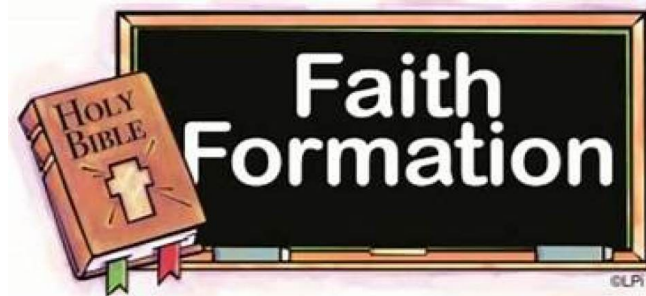
