Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday, the Church's tradition encourages us to turn toward a sort of practice in experience the joy of the holiday season which is quickly approaching. "Gaudete" Sunday or "Be joyful" points to the essential element of Christian belief that is happiness in living as a child of God. The proclamation of St. John the Baptist and the joy it brings is a great preface to the joy of the Christmas season. The bishop, Jacques-Bénigne Bossuet describes the season for which we prepare in an adept way:

"True gatherings of the friends and families of Christians should have for their object to celebrate the mercy that God has shown to us....God weaves the fabric of his designs in a wonderful order. He intended the birth of John the Baptist to be celebrated in the prophecy of Zechariah. It was important to the plan of God that the one he would send to announce his Son to the world should be famous from his birth. So here, under the pretext of ordinary civility, God gathers together those who would be the witnesses of the glory of John the Baptist, so that all would go on to be amazed." (Méditations sur l'Avent, 28.)


No classes on December 24th and December 31 for the Christmas and New Years.






