Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday prepares more intently for the coming of the Lord. St. John the Baptist is making his message exceedingly clear as the time draws close for his own execution and the beginning of the journey of Christ to make his identity as the Messiah known to the world. The bishop, Jacques-Bénigne Bossuet points out the crucial part of St. John's mission as he anticipates Christ:

It was important to the plan of God that the one he would send to announce his Son to the world should be famous from his birth; born of a woman once 'considered barren,' under the pretext of ordinary civility, God gathers together those who would be the witnesses of the glory of John the Baptist, those who would speak of and remember his birth...Let us accustom ourselves to noting that the actions that seem most ordinary are secretly directed by the order of God and serve his designs without our noticing it, in a way that nothing comes to pass by mere coincidence. (*Méditations sur l'Avent*, 28.)

Above all, let us rejoice that the Lord has made us members of his flock and knows each of us by name. Let us follow him with joy and let him guide us in all our ways.
