# *Message from the Pastor -*

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Next month, as part of an ongoing effort to increase our diocesan understanding of and connection with the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist, there will be a **Diocesan Eucharistic Congress on Sunday, June 8, 2025, at St. Anthony's High School in Huntington**. This will be a landmark moment in our local Church, where the faithful of Long Island can gather for Mass, talks with dynamic speakers, Eucharistic adoration, confession, music, fellowship, and faith-filled programming for all ages. We truly hope it will reignite and deepen Eucharistic devotion across Long Island.

Registration is free and now open at [drvc.org/congress](http://drvc.org/congress), where you can find the full day's schedule and all information about the two Eucharistic pilgrimages—from Montauk and Rockville Centre, May 31 through June 8. In the days leading up to the Congress, the two Eucharistic pilgrimages will be traveling through our Diocese from May 31st to June 8th. The Eastern Route begins with a special Opening Mass at 10:00am in Montauk at the Church of St. Therese on May 31st. These pilgrimages will include public processions, parish stops, and times of prayer and worship, all culminating at the Eucharistic Congress on June 8th. You are invited to join any part of the route—whether walking, driving, or praying along the way. The full pilgrimage schedule is available online at [drvc.org/congress](http://drvc.org/congress), along with free registration for the Eucharistic Congress itself and other information regarding the Congress. While the distance may be off-putting, especially during that time of the year, if one has the time, this is an opportunity to deepen one's devotion to and knowledge of the Eucharist.

Let us walk together—literally and spiritually—toward a deeper love of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. Mark your calendars for Sunday, June 8th.

WIC provides healthy food and information about nutrition to pregnant women, brand new and breastfeeding mothers, and their babies and children up to five years of age.



## PARTICIPANTS RECEIVE:

- Healthy food that may include: infant formula, baby food, milk, cheese, eggs, beans, peanut butter, juice, canned fish, cereal, bread, rice, tortillas, pasta, tofu, yogurt, etc.
- Approx. **\$26/month** worth of fruits and vegetables for children and **\$47/month** for mothers
- Nutrition counseling for families and help and support with breastfeeding
- Immunization screening and referrals to healthcare providers and community programs

WIC is an income based program. If you receive SNAP or Medicaid you are also eligible for WIC!
