Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday, we hear of Christ's experience with Ss. Mary and Martha which is able to present an important lesson in maintaining a peaceful Christian mind.

The overall point of the two sisters each fulfilling their responsibilities is often misconstrued as a dichotomy or even quarrel which points to a severe degree of angst in the womens' household. On the contrary, this particular section of St. Luke's Gospel is not to suggest a chasm between prayer and action (Mary's and Martha's respective purviews in the account) but instead aims at showing the complementarity of the two stations of life so that we may understand Christian cooperation.

Simply put, we are not alone in the practice of the faith and we are united in the spiritual work that is before us; each of our Christian talents adds to a united effort of peaceful minds in a just world; informed and responsible work that leads to just action.

This interaction of the two ladies with Christ reveals the revelation of God which can come from our keeping in touch with him in our daily lives so that prayer and action are united in the pursuit of holiness. Let us enjoy the sacraments which he presents to us this day, especially the Eucharist, so that we may fully enjoy his presence.
