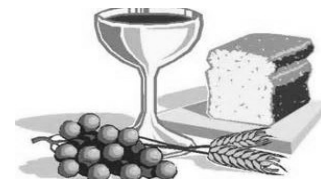

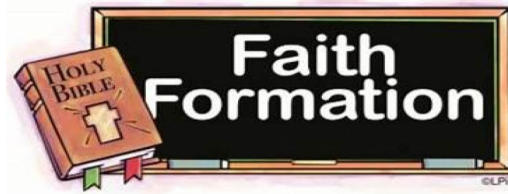

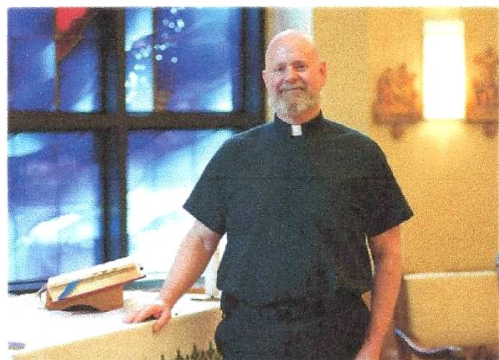


Embracing the Legacy of Service

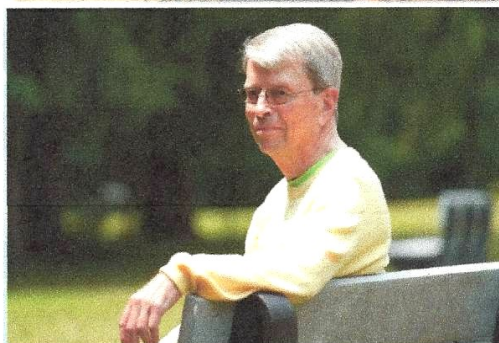
