Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we move into the week of Election Day and the popular focus on the great American franchise becomes very prevalent, we must remember the importance of prayer for the society, civilization, and nation in which we live and try to prosper both for daily life but also spiritually.

During the Constitutional Congress, tempers tended to flare from time to time and it was no lesser an intellect than Benjamin Franklin who made a motion for starting the morning with prayer (something which would have been thorny itself, given the different Christian denominations which were represented in the practice of different members.) Nonetheless, the motion was accepted and a greater peacefulness and amity existed in that crucial assembly. His words are useful:

“All of us, who were engaged in the struggle, must have observed frequent instances of a superintending Providence in our favor. To that kind Providence we owe this happy opportunity of consulting in peace on the means of establishing our future national felicity. And have we now forgotten that powerful friend?... I have lived... a long time; and the longer I live, the more convincing proofs I see of this truth, that God governs in the affairs of men!” -Franklin's motion, James Madison, *Notes on the Federal Convention*.

The old scholar from Philadelphia makes a good point that pertains to every day of the year, certainly; the sentiment is important for our particular time. Let us pray well this week that security, right judgment, and serenity may be reflected in our decisions and conduct, with trust and confidence in care of God the Father.

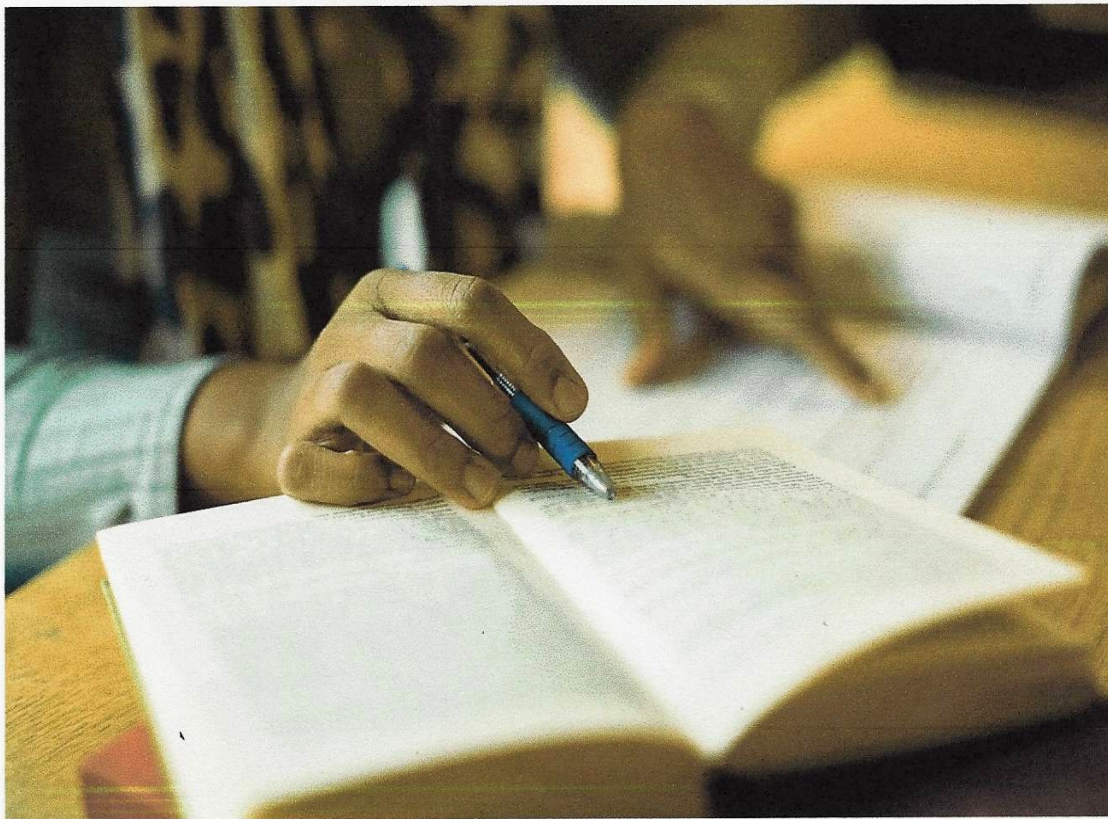
