“Strive to enter through the narrow gate.”
-Luke 13,24.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As with last week’s Sunday Gospel, we encounter Christ once again using strict language, or tough talk, to sufficiently express the details of his mission as the Messiah.

At the initial encounter with Christ, one must recognize the difference between intrinsic good and undeniable evil and pursue that which is good. In His time, good was outweighed by evil; in our time arguments could be made for whether we are better or worse than biblical times, but there is no denying that we have Christian hope to power us through any evil situation, unlike the pre-Christian era.

Christ’s tough words which he uses as his foundation for the expression of the “narrow gate” require us to consider how he wants each of us to operate as baptized Christians. During this time of year, wooden splinters are frequent for many people who spend time outdoors. Be it the door or hand, it certainly cannot be ignored. The splinter may be small, if not almost unnoticeable, but it has great effect and its removal can be time-consuming- it also changes the entire course of one’s day. In a similar sense, the individual Christian can be like a splinter of grace. Regardless of our grandeur, or lack thereof, the authentic presence in the conscience of another as part of living in a holy way as a Christian in the world can produce a major effect. Courtesy, sacrifice, and the rejection of evil in one person can turn another person’s world around in ways beyond our predictions.

This Sunday, let us commit ourselves to channeling the grace of God to others in all the ways and means by which the Holy Spirit calls us.

The Church of Most Holy Trinity in East Hampton is seeking a full-time Parish Assistant; Monday-Friday, 9am-5pm. This position involves managing the day-to-day needs of the parish office while also coordinating the day-to-day operations of the cemetery. Applicant must possess a solid knowledge of the Catholic Faith, especially sacraments, traditions and customs. Individual will report to the Pastor.

Major Responsibilities

- Assist the pastor with clerical and administrative needs as directed
- Administer parish cemetery inquiries including coordinating with funeral homes, sale of grave plots, and ensuring the maintenance of the cemetery grounds
- Answer the parish phone, greet parishioners and attend to their needs
- Maintain parish database and sacrament registers
- Provide administrative support for the pastor including all correspondence
- Maintain all sacramental records at the parish
- Maintain parish master calendar, census data, Mass cards
- Coordinate key parish ministries, such as baptisms, weddings and funerals
- Oversees weekly collections
- Provide support for parish events
- Prepare weekly bulletin


