Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. John 14, 27.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The last week has ushered in a return to the days when we would pray for peace in the Middle East due to violence. Personally, as a schoolchild, I remember the phrase "Peace in the Middle East" being cited so frequently that it was in song lyrics and repeated very often in school as a throwaway line.

The current violence is a terrible regress to those days when life in the Holy Land was tenuous. The power of our prayer is now called upon. Our Christian responsibility to pray for peace is before us and it behooves us to pray well. Though we may be far away, we must always remember the strength and power of our prayer beyond the physical and material realm for those in conflict and despair. I recommend the prayer for peace by St. Francis of Assisi:

Lord, make me an instrument of your peace:
where there is hatred, let me sow love;
where there is injury, pardon;
where there is doubt, faith;
where there is despair, hope;
where there is darkness, light;
where there is sadness, joy.

O divine Master, grant that I may not so much seek to be consoled as to console, to be understood as to understand, to be loved as to love.

For it is in giving that we receive, it is in pardoning that we are pardoned, and it is in dying that we are born to eternal life.

Amen.




