Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The month of October is both the month dedicated to the Holy Rosary and also devotion to the Angels. October 2nd is the Feast of the Guardian Angels and it inaugurates a month where we can recognize our connection with the Lord through a constant exchange. One of the eminent Catholic philosophers of our time, Roberto DeMattei has described the connection between the assistance of angels in our lives accordingly:

Angels, from the first moment of creation, have sided for or against God, for eternity. This choice we have to make in the historical time in which we live, and the worship of angels helps us to serve God and effectively fight his adversaries. Therefore, devotion to angels is an act of love for the supernatural order willed by God. This devotion is even more important than the devotion we have to the saints. For the saints are models of virtue whom we should imitate and pray for them to intercede for us. They do not, however, have, except in extraordinary cases, that power over creatures that angels ordinarily have over the created universe. *RdM, Rorate Caeli, (10/2/23.)*

With the announcement of the Incarnation to the Blessed Virgin Mary by the Archangel Gabriel, we see the connection in this month between humanity and the Lord as we cooperate in holiness. Let's trust in the care of angels, especially our guardian angels, and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, recognizing that we too move forward through holy lives with heavenly assistance.

The Sisters of St. Dominic of Amityville Host Autumn Evening Event

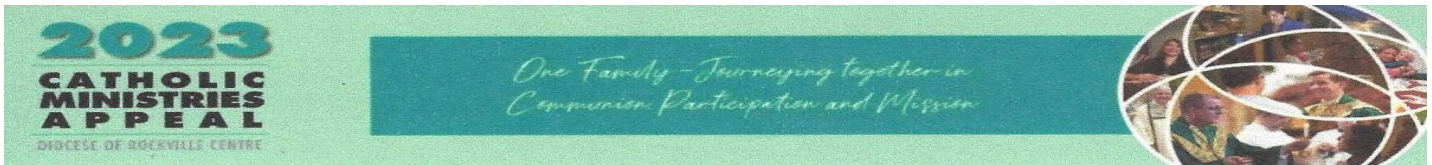
