Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Most Holy Trinity's appearance may seem a bit different this weekend. There has been a combination of suggestions regarding the movement of our tabernacle back to its original location. In the last week, we had the opportunity for our construction contacts to restore the Blessed Sacrament to its original location in the center of the sanctuary, ironically thanks to bad weather that prevented them from working outdoors elsewhere.

The relocation of the original altar to its initial location (as can be seen on the following page) is practical in that the weight of the altar and tabernacle is better accommodated by the foundation of the sanctuary. It was also in need of reinforcement and cleaning.

More importantly, it is spiritually helpful to each of us in that it places the Holy Eucharist in the center of our consideration when we enter the church, when we are praying, and when we depart in peace. It also takes the focus off of the celebrant's bench and restores it to the Lord during our celebration of the sacraments. Mounted on the historic piece which nourished generations of our family and friends before us, we are more easily able to contemplate our own connection with the Lord, just as we are able to in St. Peter's and the Parish Hall.

The work done also has given us the opportunity to move on to arrange for cleaning up the floor in the front of the church so that we'll be well situated for the upcoming year as Autumn approaches.

While most of the work is done, there are still some small works in progress that need wrapping up, so please pray to our Lord for success; He's never hard to find.

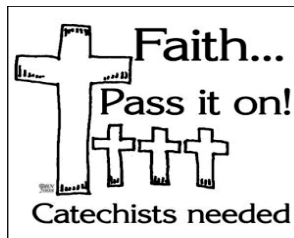


Classes today Sunday, September 24th, for the students in the A class.
