Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday, Christ's exhortation provides a useful focus for the Christian mind to prioritize the things of earth over the things of Heaven. Pope St. Leo the Great, speaking from the Church's early days, offers a helpful way of understanding the importance of pricing the Heavenly reward above earthly rewards:

We must not indulge in folly amid vain pursuits, nor give way to fear in the midst of adversities. On the one side, no doubt, we are flattered by deceits, and on the other weighed down by troubles; but because "the earth is full of the mercy of the Lord, Psalm. 33,5." Christ's victory is assuredly ours, that what He says may be fulfilled, "Fear not, for I have overcome the world. John 16,33" Whether, then, we fight against the ambition of the world, or against the lusts of the flesh, or against the darts of heresy, let us arm ourselves always with the Lord's Cross. For our Paschal feast will never end, if we abstain from the leaven of the old wickedness in the sincerity of truth. (Sermon LXXII, IV.)


