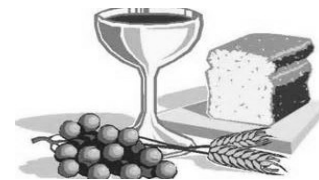

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday the Church enters into the fast season of Advent. Advent is a curious season in that it is one of the shorter seasons of the Church's year and while penitential, it is not quite as ascetic as Lent. Its character is a hard one to accurately describe, however the task is not impossible.

St. Bernard of Clairvaux preached about the Advent of the Lord: "There are three distinct comings of the Lord of which I know- His coming to men, His coming into men, and His coming against the world of men."

The saint rightly points out that above all, we are thinking about the day of great joy, when the just soul encounters the Lord. This is thanks to God embracing us, that is, we who have had him in our souls. Lastly, the cares of the world of men have not troubled us and we have triumphed over them with the help and grace of God.

For daily life, we must consider using the short time of Advent to keep our souls and minds at peace since the business of Christmas preparation makes the month go even faster for our temperaments and schedules. So let us pray well in this season and may the Lord be with us.

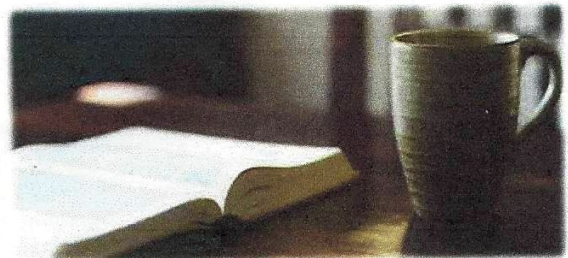
