# "Our Father, who art in heaven..." Luke 11, 2.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend we experience a hopeful exhortation to prayer by Christ. Not only does he encourage the desire to pray, but also outlines a method and provides a structure. St. Cyprian, an early doctor of the Church and a great light of the eastern church "The Lord who taught us to plead for our debts and sins also promised that his Father's merciful forgiveness would follow."

Such a promise is a great relief, without any doubt. At the same time, St. Cyprian reminds us "This prayer is only for those who can honestly call the Father 'Our.'"

The great anthem of belief is the Our Father and it is the way in which the believer is proven an authentic believer before the sight of God. Also, it attaches the believer to fellow believers and is thus a succinct way in which we are all together and praying for each other.

The Our Father is simple enough to say, especially after a lifetime of repeating it in almost all the liturgies of the Church however its power of effectiveness and unity remains undiminished. Indeed, it has only grown in its power over the course of the Church's history. The power to unite the Christian flock is one immaterial demonstration of the power of faith. This Sunday, before the altar of God, let us enjoy our unity and recognize what a wonderful method we have of allowing God's grace to flow into all our lives as individuals and as one people.




We are looking for good people to become Catechists in the fall.
