Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend will usher in the celebration of Halloween, All Saints Day, and All Souls Day. Over the course of a few days, we see joyful celebration, commemorate the saints, and then commend the souls of the faithful departed to the bosom of the Lord. Such a rapid transformation is normal for the Christian and evocative of the nature of the Christian faith. In the coming month, according to our custom, we will devote the month of November to praying especially for the dead. Let us remember that death is a predication to the encounter with God. For this reason, we must always pray for a saintly life so that the Lord will receive us well.

Our current world has presented us with such disappointment in human conduct, especially in the Middle East. In our position, we must pray for peace with the intensity of saints.

St. Bernard of Clairvaux preached the following on saintly life:

“Let us be aroused at last, brothers and sisters! Let us rise with Christ, seek what is above, set our hearts on what is above. Let us yearn for those who yearn for us, hurry on to those who look for our coming, and lay hold now, in prayer, on those who wait for us. It is not only their society but their happiness that we must look to share. We desire their presence; let us also fervently seek to share their glory.” (Sermon II.)

Class for the students in the **B** class will be on November 5<sup>th</sup>.

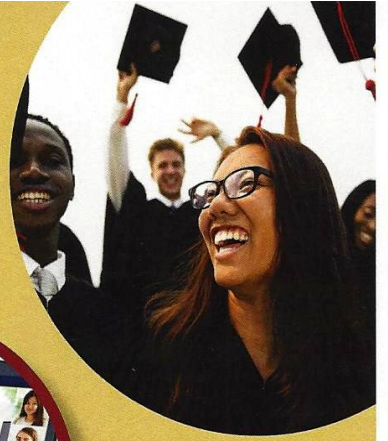
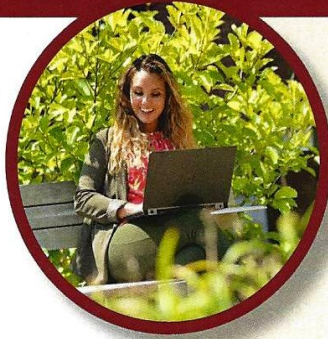
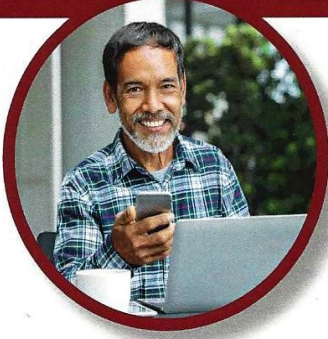
