Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Church commemorated the Feast of the Ascension on this past Thursday and it is an important moment for us as we look to the end of the Easter season. The essence of today's feast is meditation on the command of Christ to follow him, not just in healing, teaching, patience, and holiness on earth, but to heaven itself. The message of the Ascension is, now that Jesus has returned to heaven, he is closer to us than ever. When he was among us, he was limited by his physical body to a single place at a single time. With a human body circumscribed in time and space, he could not be everywhere. After his death and resurrection however, he is no longer constrained. In the end, we come to realize that the command of Christ “come follow me” is concluded with his great assurance: I am with you always. Thus, we must recognize he is close to us, not just in understanding but in the reality of action as well.

As we prepare for the celebration of Pentecost and the contemplation of the Holy Spirit in our lives on a daily basis, let us enjoy the supernatural reality of God with us at all times. In the fresh cold of winter, we celebrate Emmanuel, ‘God with us’ at Christmas. In the warm months to come, let us enjoy the Lord's closeness with the same enthusiasm and confidence.

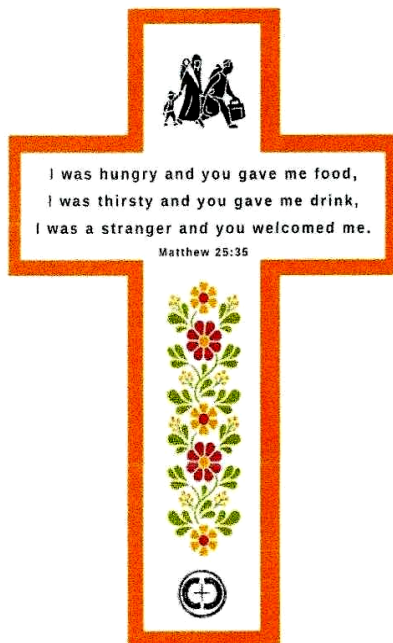
