On the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Very often we hear a familiar hymn during the veneration of the Holy Eucharist, especially on Wednesday during Exposition and the Rosary (following Mass.) The *Tantum Ergo*, written by St. Thomas Aquinas, is a helpful meditation on the glory of the Church's greatest gift, the Eucharist.

Often we sing it in Latin, so I offer a translation for our mediation on this great day for the Christian soul:

Down in adoration falling,
Lo! the sacred Host we hail;
Lo! o'er ancient forms departing,
newer rites of grace prevail;
faith for all defects supplying,
where the feeble senses fail.

To the everlasting Father,
and the Son who reigns on high,
with the Holy Ghost proceeding
forth from Each eternally,
be salvation, honor, blessing,
might and endless majesty.

Amen.

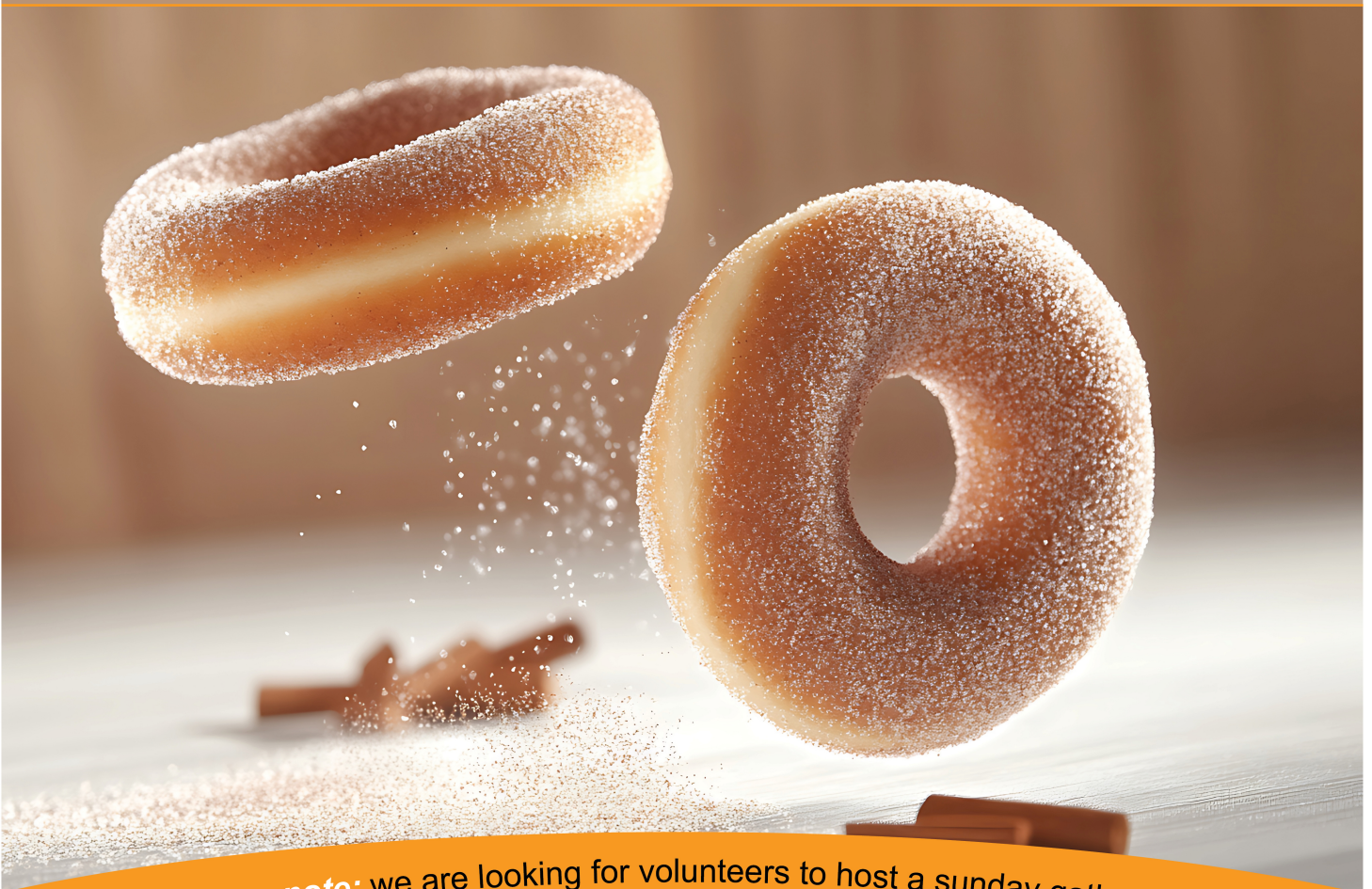
