Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Over the next couple of weekends, the parish will be taking up a second collection for the Parish Hall Boiler Replacement. The current boiler has served the Hall well since its construction but needs to be replaced; it would be best to do so before winter so that it is installed and prepped for smooth function in the winter months.

It is too early to provide an accurate estimate at this time, but it will be expensive. When more details from parts to labor become clearer, more dependable information will be provided. The office and Finance Committee are also committed to investigating assistance from the state since the Hall serves community needs well beyond being a space for liturgical functions.

In the meantime, please be generous as we handle this necessity for the parish and stay tuned.

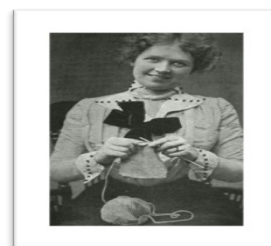
