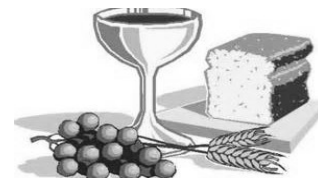

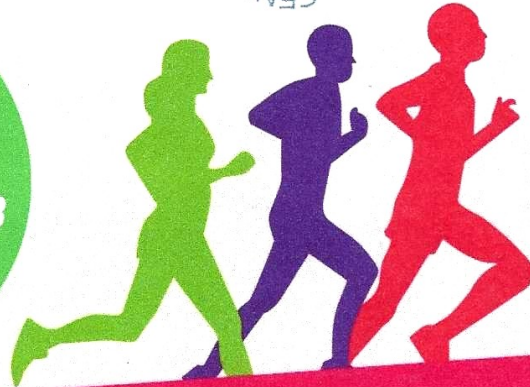
Volunteers keep the program running and they also make a difference to our young people that are in our program. Please think of becoming a catechist for the upcoming year starting in September and running to the beginning of May.
