"Jesus proclaimed the Gospel of the kingdom and cured every disease among the people."

-Mt. 4, 23.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's Gospel marks the initiation of a major turning point in the ministry of Jesus. Up until now, Christ had been laboring to bring in the lost sheep of Israel, the Jewish tribe, extended through the greater region of everyone's' consideration.

Now, with his encounter with the Canaanite woman, the glare of his mercy extends beyond the lost family of Abraham to the larger collection of humanity. The universality of God's plan is now made clear in the words we hear this Sunday.

Interestingly, this universality was not lost on the prophet Isaiah 1000 years earlier when he preached between his 40th and 55th chapters of the fact that the liberation of the exiled Jewish tribe into Babylon would be resolved at the hands of non-believers. True to his word, the pagan Cyrus, King of Persia, would be the instrument of God in returning his chosen people to their appointed land.

Each and everyone of us is an instrument of God, possessing unique talents and an unmistakable identity with historical capacity to channel the will of God. As we hear of the devotion of the Caananite woman appealing to the Lord, let us remember that the Lord has not changed. The Lord rewards faith. Let us pray well!


