Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Christ's use of the word "talent" in this Sunday's Gospel is not a strange translation or even an ironic carry-over from ancient phraseology but actually a direct tie-in to our current notion of "having a talent." The Latin *talentium* was the largest denomination of money in the Roman Empire at the time at would go on to translate to other languages (including English) as a way of identifying the capacity of making progress, "getting things done."

When Jesus speaks of talents, he includes the gift of faith. In life, those who develop their talents alongside their faith see a common growth of the two. As well, those who fail to develop their talents and faith will see them wither into non-existence.

Whether it be spreading the Gospel or tending to our own households, we must make sure there is activity based on our faith which could be called "spiritually profitable." There are no holding patterns or 'breaking even' situations for the Christian. When we pray and especially when we use the Eucharist as our nourishment for the soul, we allow for a great possibilities to capitalize on our talents and abilities and simultaneously enliven ourselves in our experience of Christian existence.

This Sunday, before God's altar, let us continue to enliven our commitment to the science of holiness that can derive from our talents.

The Move is scheduled for Sunday, November 19<sup>th</sup> after the 9:30am Mass.






