

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Gospel of this Sunday continues with Christ's dialogue with the Scribes and Pharisees. This dialogue is gradually becoming an argument, as if it were testimony with important consequences, which of course, it will.

What is at the heart of St. Matthew's recording of the dialogue is Christ's attempt to allow for the human mind to think of the supernatural and elevate beyond worldly concern. The Pharisees had unfortunately developed a system through an organic nature that was fixated on the observance of rules which did not translate to the consideration of things above. Pope St. Gregory the Great teaches us well when it comes to considering how and what the world teaches us about the Lord:

"The only true riches are those that make us rich in virtue. Therefore, if you want to be rich, beloved, love true riches. If you aspire to the heights of real honor, strive to reach the kingdom of heaven. If you value rank and renown, hasten to be enrolled in the heavenly court of angels." (Sermon XIII.)

Christmas Fair on December 2nd.


The Move is scheduled for Sunday, November 19th after the 9:30am Mass.




