Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Feast of the Transfiguration is a great moment for the Church as we consider the nature of Christ. To understand the nature of Christ over the course of one’s Christian life is to accompany the Holy Spirit as he guides us through daily life- it is not an academic exercise but rather another element of praying well to God and keeping our connection with him strong. St. Anastasius of Sinai, an early Church bishop, describes the Feast of the Transfiguration’s impact on our Christian task well:

“Let us listen, then, to the sacred voice of God so compellingly calling us from on high, from the summit of the mountain, so that with the Lord’s chosen disciples we may penetrate the deep meaning of these holy mysteries, so far beyond our capacity to express. Jesus goes before us to show us the way, both up the mountain and into heaven, and—I speak boldly—it is for us now to follow him with all speed, yearning for the heavenly vision that will give us a share in his radiance, renew our spiritual nature and transform us into his own likeness, making us forever sharers in his Godhead and raising us to heights as yet undreamed of.

Let us run with confidence and joy to enter into the cloud like Moses and Elijah, or like James and John. Let us be caught up like Peter to behold the divine vision and to be transfigured by that glorious transfiguration. Let us retire from the world, stand aloof from the earth, rise above the body, detach ourselves from creatures and turn to the creator, to whom Peter in ecstasy exclaimed: Lord, it is good for us to be here.”(Nn. 6-10: Melanges d’archéologie et d’histoire 67.)

May the wisdom of the ancients guide us in the present to happy futures while we contemplate the Lord who is beyond time.
