Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This week we will commemorate the great theological understanding of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary; it is also a great American commemoration since the Virgin Mary under the title of the Immaculate Conception is the patroness of the United States of America. An ancient devotion attached to a still-young nation (in the eyes of history) is a perfect example of the strength and transmission of the Christian faith. As we proceed deeper into the Advent season, meditation on the Blessed Virgin Mary and prayer to her are appropriate and a strong way for spiritual inspiration. The ancient *Salve Maria* is one worth recalling:
