Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Church begins the new year with the initial feast of St. Mary, the Mother of God but caps its Christmas season with the commemoration of the visit of the three wise men to the manger in Bethlehem as a wonderful way of reminding us of how the presence of the Lord in our midst allows for the transformation of our lives in an intense way. From the heights of our experience, a closeness with Christ can transform everything beyond one’s normal experience. St. Angela of Foligno speaks well in one of her spiritual writings during the height of the medieval period:

“By virtue of love is the lover transformed in the beloved and the beloved is transformed in the love. Just as hard iron in the forge takes on the color, heat, energy, and form of the fire to such a degree that it almost turns into fire, so the soul, united with God through the perfect grace of divine love, will itself become almost divine and transformed in God.” *(Libro, 36.)*

The saint reminds us that the encounter with the Lord can transform the smartest of minds, the holiest of souls, and even the most despairing of spirits when we humble ourselves before him.

In this coming year, may we be humble and close to God and so enjoy the peace and grace that comes from his presence.

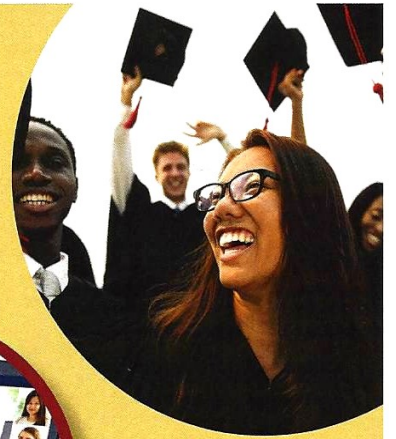
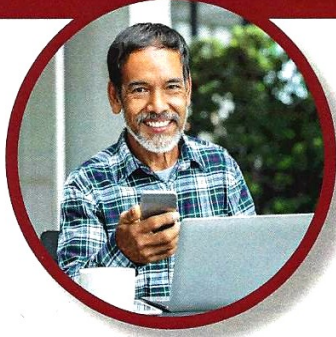
