Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday the Church’s tradition welcomes us to contemplate a very moving moment in the life of Christ and his Apostles which is very appropriate for us this summer- the calming of the waters by drawing close to his cherished disciples.

We have enjoyed a good summer, as far as the environment goes, according to most estimations and so we know how the peace of the world around us is always something for which we should be grateful.

At the same time, his blessings in daily existence point to a greater reality, that of his connection to our heavenly calling. St. Catherine of Siena preached well as to how close God is to us:

“Moved by love and wishing to reconcile the human race to yourself, you gave us your only-begotten Son. He became our mediator and our justice by taking on all our injustice and sins out of obedience to your will, eternal Father, just as you willed that he take on our human nature. What an immeasurably profound love! Your Son went down from the heights of his divinity to the depth of our humanity. Can anyone’s heart remain closed and hardened after this?” (Dialogue on Divine Providence, 4, 13.)

Whether we give thanks for the blessings of daily life or are addressing the Lord for deep necessity, let us call out with the strength of St. Peter as seen in this Sunday’s Gospel, with unmitigated confidence.
